## **Uniform Reminders**

A reminder that we expect all students to be smartly dressed in Swan School uniform every day. This to reinforce our professional learning environment and minimise opportunities for differences between students, which can be exploited. Just a couple of reminders about specific areas of uniform.

- **PE Kit** - trousers/shorts/skirts must be plain navy blue, not black. Student will receive an expectations detention if they are not in the correct kit.
- **Vests/Under-shirts** - in this cold weather, we are happy for students to wear a warm layer underneath their shirt. However, this must be a neutral colour that is not visible through their shirt (e.g. white) and should be in addition to, not a replacement for, their school jumper.
- **Coats** - if students choose to wear a coat, it must be plain and dark coloured. High visibility (reflective) items for cycling are also allowed. We recommend a waterproof item. Hoodies are not allowed.
