Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, I would like to say thank you, once again, for your ongoing support during this challenging time. We have been so impressed by the strength of our community and how well families have adapted to this difficult situation.

Following the Prime Minister's announcement yesterday evening, I would like to re-confirm that there is currently no change to the closure of schools for the majority of pupils - we remain closed for all students, except the children of key workers and vulnerable children. All things being well, it is likely that primary schools may start to open for some students in the next few weeks, and that some secondary school pupils in certain year groups (those taking exams next year) may be invited back for a short period before the summer holiday.

We are currently awaiting further information from the government regarding secondary schools. Let me reassure you that, once we have this information, we will plan our next steps very carefully with the safety and wellbeing of students and staff foremost in our minds. We will ensure that families are fully informed of any decisions we make in a detailed and timely way.

We hope to put out a statement with further information later this week. In the meantime, please do let us know if you have any questions or we can help in any way. Please continue to keep yourselves and your families safe.
